Briefing

The education sector in the emirate of Abu Dhabi is one of the most important sectors that contribute to the development of a promising and educated generation that contributes to the service of the nation and society. The department of education and knowledge monitors the three main types of education in Abu Dhabi: public schools, private schools and higher education. To raise the quality of education to the highest international standards to ensure that all residents have access to quality education to achieve the objectives of Abu Dhabi Vision 2030 and the objectives of the Abu Dhabi Plan.

Statistics Center-Abu Dhabi has been working on the Education Price Index project within the Emirate. Which is one of the first statistical centers to set up a special price index for education.

Key Points

- The Education Price Index in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi increased by 4.4% in 2017 compared to 2016. The Education Price Index in 2017 was 104.4% and 100.0% in 2016.
- Al Ain region achieved the highest increase in Education Price Index by 4.8% in 2017 compared with 2016, followed by Abu Dhabi by 4.5% and Al Dhafra by 3.9%.
- The "primary and pre-primary" group achieved the highest contribution to the rise in 2017 compared to 2016, contributing 58.3% of the total increase. Where prices rose by 4.8%.
- The "secondary education" group increased by 10.6%, contributing 39.5% of the total increase.
- The "higher education" group declined by 0.2%, which led to a reduction of the overall increase by 1.0%.
- The "non-standard education" group declined by 7.1% and contributed 2.0% to the reduction of the rise.
