Introduction

The monthly publication of Building Materials Price Statistics is of great significance as building material prices are deemed to be important economic indicators for planning and research in various fields. They are also used in the compilation of indices of the construction activity and for the calculation of GDP at constant prices.

Statistical centres all over the world collect prices of building materials used by a large segment of people. As a result of the urban development and the constant growth in the construction sector in the Emirate, Statistics Centre – Abu Dhabi collects price data for these materials on a regular basis.

The movements of prices of 21 groups from the key building materials are included in this publication (table 4). This information helps decision and policy makers and researchers in planning and making sound decisions in support of the building materials sector and other sectors associated with it.

Key Points

This publication provides an analysis of the movement of the average prices of building materials during the month of August 2015 compared with July 2015 and August 2014. The key changes were:

- During August 2015 the average prices of the 'Employment', 'Tiles and marble' and 'Wood' groups increased by 6.5%, 5.1% and 5.0% respectively, compared with July 2015.
- During August 2015 the price of 'Diesel' decreased by 12.8%, 'False ceiling' by 9.6% and 'Aggregates and sand' by 6.3% compared with July 2015.
- During August 2015 the average price of the 'Employment' group increased by 16.5%, 'Tiles and marble' by 10.7% and 'Wood' by 2.9% compared with August 2014.
- During August 2015, the average prices of 'Steel', 'Waterproofing products' and 'Power cable' decreased by 20.4%, 16.3% and 15.9% respectively, compared with the same period in the previous year.

1. Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for August 2015 compared with July 2015

The increases in the average prices in August 2015 compared with July 2015, ranged between 1.2% for the 'Waterproofing products' group and 6.5% for the 'Employment' group. Decreases ranging from 1.0% for '(uPVC) Pipes' to 12.8% for the 'Diesel' group were recorded.

Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' increased by 6.5% in August 2015 compared with July 2015. Table (1) shows increases between 9.4% and 17.6%.

Tiles and marble

The average prices of 'Tiles and marble' increased by 5.1% in August 2015 compared with July 2015, as a result of an increase in marble prices.

Wood

The average prices of 'Wood' increased by 5.0% in August 2015 compared with July 2015, as a result of an increase in most items in this group.

Glass

The average prices of 'Glass' increased by 3.6% in August 2015 compared with July 2015, as a result of an increase in some items in this group.

Diesel

The price of 'Diesel' decreased by 12.8% in August 2015 compared with July 2015.

Aggregates and sand

The average prices of 'Aggregates and sand' decreased by 6.3% in August 2015 compared with July 2015, as a result of a decrease in most items in this group.

Steel

The average prices of 'Steel' decreased by 5.6% in August 2015 compared with July 2015.

False ceiling

The average prices of 'False ceiling' decreased by 9.6% in August 2015 compared with July 2015, as a result of a decrease in most items in this group.


2. Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for August 2015 compared with August 2014

The monthly average prices for 16 groups of building materials have decreased in August 2015 compared with August 2014. The decreases ranged between 0.1% for 'Paints' and 20.4% for 'Steel'.

Steel

The average prices of the 'Steel' group decreased by 20.4% in August 2015 compared with August 2014.

Waterproofing products

The average prices of 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 16.3% in August 2015 compared with August 2014, as a result of decreases in most items in this group.

Power cable

The average prices of 'Power cable' decreased by 15.9% in August 2015 compared with August 2014, as a result of a decrease in all items in this group.



Some building materials items have seen an increase in August 2015 compared with August 2014:

Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' increased by 16.5% in August 2015 compared with August 2014, as a result of increases in most items in this group.

Tiles and marble

The 'Tiles and marble' group increased by 10.7% in August 2015 compared with August 2014.

Wood

The average prices of 'Wood' increased by 2.9% in August 2015 compared with August 2014, with most items in the group recording an increase.
