## **Building Materials**

**Price Statistics**

### Introduction

The monthly publication of Building Materials Price Statistics is of great significance as building material prices are deemed to be important economic indicators for planning and research in various fields. They are also used in the compilation of indices of the construction activity and for the calculation of GDP at constant prices.

Statistical centres all over the world collect prices of building materials used by a large segment of people. As a result of the urban development and the constant growth in the construction sector in the Emirate, Statistics Centre – Abu Dhabi collects price data for these materials on a regular basis.

The movements of prices of 21 groups from the key building materials are included in this publication (table 5). This information helps decision and policy makers and researchers in planning and making sound decisions in support of the building materials sector and other sectors associated with it.

### **Key Points**

This publication provides an analysis of the movement of the average prices of building materials during the month of January 2016 compared with December 2015 and January 2015. The key changes were:

- During January 2016 the average prices of the 'Pipes (PVC)', 'Wires for apartment' and 'Wires for small building' groups increased by 4.2%, 1.3% and 0.8% respectively, compared with December 2015.
- During January 2016 the average price of 'Employment' decreased by 14.1%, 'Diesel' by 12.0% and 'Waterproofing products' by 5.7% compared with December 2015.
- During January 2016 the average price of the 'False ceiling' group increased by 11.0%, 'Tiles and marble' by 8.4% and 'Glass' by 7.6% compared with January 2015.
- During January 2016, the average prices of 'Diesel', 'Steel' and 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 31.5%, 24.9% and 22.3% respectively, compared with the same period in the previous year.

# Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for January 2016 compared with December 2015

The increases in the average prices in January 2016 compared with December 2015, ranged between 0.1% for the 'Wires for residential towers' group and 4.2% for the 'Pipes (PVC)' group. Decreases ranging from 0.2% for 'Transport equipment' and 14.1% for the 'Employment' group were recorded.

#### Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' decreased by 14.1% in January 2016 compared with December 2015. Table (1) shows changes in wages of 'Employment' during January 2016.

#### Diesel

The price of 'Diesel' decreased by 12.0% in January 2016 compared with December 2015.

#### Waterproofing products

The average prices of 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 5.7% in January 2016 compared with December 2015, as a result of a decrease in some items in this group.

#### Steel

The average prices of 'Steel' decreased by 4.2% in January 2016 compared with December 2015, as a result of an increase in most items in this group.

#### Pipes (PVC)

The average prices of 'Pipes (PVC)' increased by 4.2% in January 2016 compared with December 2015.

#### Wires

The average prices of 'Wires' increased in January 2016 compared with December 2015. 'Wires for apartment' accounted for the largest increase of 1.3%, followed by 'Small buildings' with 0.8% and 'Wires for residential towers' which increased by 0.1%.

# Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for January 2016 compared with January 2015

The monthly average prices for 13 groups of building materials have decreased in January 2016 compared with January 2015. The decreases ranged between 0.6% for 'Transport equipment' and 31.5% for 'Diesel'.

#### Diesel

The price of 'Diesel' decreased by 31.5% in January 2016 compared with January 2015.

#### Steel

The average prices of the 'Steel' group decreased by 24.9% in January 2016 compared with January 2015.

#### Waterproofing products

The average prices of 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 22.3% in January 2016 compared with January 2015.

#### Power cable

The average prices of 'Power cable' decreased by 12.0% in January 2016 compared with January 2015, as a result of a decrease in all items in this group.

Some building materials items have seen an increase in January 2016 compared with January 2015:

#### **False ceiling**

The average prices of 'False ceiling' increased by 11.0% in January 2016 compared with January 2015.


#### **Tiles and marble**

The 'Tiles and marble' group increased by 8.4% in January 2016 compared with January 2015.

#### Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' increased by 5.2% in January 2016 compared with January 2015, as a result of increases in most items in this group.
