Briefing

The monthly publication of Building Materials Price Statistics is of great significance as building material prices are deemed to be important economic indicators for planning and research in various fields. They are also used in the compilation of indices of the construction activity and for the calculation of GDP at constant prices.

Statistical centers all over the world collect prices of building materials used by a large segment of people. As a result of the urban development and the constant growth in the construction sector in the Emirate, Statistics Centre – Abu Dhabi collects price data for these materials on a regular basis.

The movements of prices of 21 groups from the key building materials are included in this publication. This information helps decision and policy makers and researchers in planning and making sound decisions in support of the building materials sector and other sectors associated with it.

Key Points

This publication provides the movement of prices of twenty-one groups of building materials in March 2020 compared with February 2020 and March 2019. The main results are as follows:

- During March 2020, the average prices of 'Natural stone' increased by 11.8%, '(PVC) Pipes' by 8.9%, and '(uPVC) Pipes' by 4.0% compared with February 2020.
- During March 2020, the average prices of 'Employment/ with all services' decreased by 11.5%,
 'Block' by 8.2%, and 'Power Cable' decreased by 8.1% compared with February 2020.
- During March 2020, the average prices of 'Natural stone' increased by 6.4%, 'Cement' increased by 4.2% and 'Wires for Small Building' increased by 3.2% compared with March 2019.
- During March 2020, the average prices of '(PVC) Pipes' decreased by 13.9%, 'Power Cable' decreased by 10.9%, and 'Employment/ with all services' decreased by 9.8% compared with March 2019.



- During the First quarter of 2020 compared with the fourth quarter of 2019, the average prices of the 'Natural Stone' group increased by 5.0%, 'Wires for Small Building' by 4.5%, and 'Wires for Residential Towers' by 2.7%. The average prices of, 'Employment\ with all services' decreased by 3.7%, '(PVC) Pipes' decreased by 3.4%, and 'Wires for Apartments' by 3.2% compared with the fourth quarter 2019.
- During the First quarter of 2020 compared with the same period in the previous year, the average prices of 'Cement' increased by 5.7%, the prices of 'Bathroom Set without Accessories' increased by 2.4%, and 'False ceiling' increased by 1.8%. The average prices of '(PVC) Pipes' decreased by 18.0%, 'Waterproofing products' by 7.5%, and 'Bathroom Set with Accessories' by 5.2%.

Technical notes

The current methodology for Building Materials Price Statistics including conceptual basis, construction of the basket, data collection, validation, processing procedures, averaging and treatment of missing values, and potential sources of error are described in the Building Materials Price Statistics 2015 publication, which is available on SCAD's website at www.scad.gov.abudhabi.

Data sources

Data are obtained from the monthly survey of Building Materials Prices; the data are collected, processed and passed to Statistic Centre – Abu Dhabi for further editing and compilation.

Glossary

building Materials Prices: Monthly statistics to measure the relative change in the prices of Building Materials Price Statistics basket in Abu Dhabi.

Comparison period: This is the period of time for which we want to compare prices with another period.

Base period: is the period of time over which the current period is compared Relative change: the ratio resulting from dividing the change in the current number by the previous number divided by the previous number multiplied by 100%.

Symbols used: '-' means no price.
