### **Introduction**

This report presents statistics on key energy and water figures in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi for the year 2013, compromising statistics of Oil and Natural Gas, Statistics of Electrical Energy and Desalinated Water Consumption. The main sources of these statistics are Abu Dhabi National Oil Company - ADNOC, TAKREER, Abu Dhabi Water and Electricity Company.

# **Key points**

#### 1. Oil and Refined Petroleum Statistics


Oil and gas sector is one of the most important pillars of Abu Dhabi economy, forming a large share of the GDP. The total production of Abu Dhabi crude oil in 2013 was 996,928 thousand barrels, of which 920,687 thousand barrels were exported to other countries. Crude oil exports represented about 92.4% of the production of the same year. The amount of production in 2013 increased by 48,728 thousand barrels or 5.1% compared to 2012 and as a result, petroleum products increased in 2013 by 4.2% compared to 2012.



#### 2. Natural Gas Statistics

The importance of natural gas stems from the variation of its uses in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, such as liquefied fuel and other products such as propane, butane and pentane. It is also used in industries such as iron and steel, aluminum, cement. Natural gas is also re-injected in the oil wells to increase productivity and maintain pressure oil reservoir. The total production of Abu Dhabi Natural Gas in 2013 was 2,756 billion cubic feet, which is an decrease of (1.3)% compared to 2012.





# 3. Electrical Energy Statistics

Water and electricity sector is deemed to be one of the most important sectors supporting development and serving the community. It also provides basic and necessary services for Economic activities, Citizens and Non-Citizens. The total electric power generated in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in 2013 was about 51,937 GWH, an increase of about 32.4% during the period since 2009. The electric power consumed during the same period increased by 93.8%, reaching 49,267 GWH. This includes the internal consumption by power stations as well as losses through the network. Energy is produced through generators by burning fossil fuels where natural gas forms 99.96% of the total fuel consumed due to economic, technical and environmental considerations.

## 4. Desalinated water consumption

The Emirate of Abu Dhabi consumed from desalinated water about 1,082.5 MCM in 2013, with a daily average of 3 MCM and per capita average daily consumption of 1.21 cubic metres. Consumption of desalinated water increased by 37.0% from 2009 and this rise is the result of increasing demand on water from various sectors.
