# 05. Labour Force

Results of the labour force survey in the fourth quarter of 2012 showed that the estimated total number in the labour force were 1,628 thousands, with 16.0% female. While the Refined participation rate reached 82.4%, the Economic Dependency Ratio reached 49.0%.



## 5.1. Labour Force Structure

The labour force includes employed and unemployed individuals who are aged 15 Years and above. Data showed that Abu Dhabi Region had the largest share of labour force with 56.9%, followed by Al Ain Region with 27.5%, and Al Gharbia with 15.5%.

Data on age structure of labour force in 2012 indicated that the 25-29 age group accounted for the largest share of labour force with 24.5%.

# 5.2. Employment

The estimated total number of employed persons who are aged 15 Years and above amounted to 1,577,013, with around 57.1% in Abu Dhabi Region. The total number of employed males amounted to 1,344,424, while employed females were 232,589.

The distribution by work status revealed that majority of employed persons in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi were paid employees by 97.0%, while 1.3% were own-account worker.

In regard to the educational structure of employees, data indicated that the largest share of them have a primary education 20.2%, followed by lower secondary degree 17.3%. The highest share of citizen employees has upper secondary education 30.9 %.

Indicators of employed population by main occupation showed that Craft or related trades had the largest share of employee with 25.7%, followed by Elementary occupations with 22.8%. In regard to citizen employees, data indicated that Service or sales worker occupations accounted for the largest share of employed persons with 23.7%, while Craft and related trades, and Elementary occupations had the largest shares of non-citizens with 27.7% and 24.6% respectively.

Data showed that the largest share of employee was in Construction activity with 30.1%, followed by Activities of households as employers undifferentiated goods & services with 11.4%, meanwhile Activities of extraterritorial organizations & bodies accounted for the lowest share of employees with 0.1%. Data showed that Public administration & defence; compulsory social security activities accounted for the largest share of citizen employees with 65.5%, while Construction accounted for the largest share of non-citizens with 32.5%.

Statistics indicated that private sector had the largest share of employees with 65.1%, followed by government sector with 15.2%. For citizen employees, 86.4% are in the government sector and 5.7% in the private sector.







# 5.3. Unemployment

Unemployment rate in 2012 was about 3.2% compared with 2.8% in 2011 estimates. The 20-24 age group accounted for the largest share of the unemployed persons by 27.5%. Data showes female unemployment rate in 2012 is higher than that for male and reached around 10.6%.
