## 5. Labour Force

According to estimates based on the labour force survey covering the fourth quarter of 2018, the labour force constitutes 65.2% as a percentage of the total population and 79.0% as a percentage of the population aged 15+. Females made up 25.6% of the total labour force. The economic dependency ratio was of 53.4%.



### 5.1. Labour Force Structure

The labour force includes employed and unemployed individuals who are aged 15 years and above. 2018 Data showed that Abu Dhabi Region had the largest share of the labour force with 61.7% followed by Al Ain Region with 24.9% and Al Dhafra Region with 13.5%.

Data on age structure of the labour force in 2018 indicated that the 30 to 34 years age group accounted for the largest share of the labour force with 21.7%

Refined Economic Participation Rate by region was highest in the Al Dhafra Region, followed by Abu Dhabi Region and Al Ain Region 91.2%, 78.6%% and 74.3% respectively.

### 5.2. Employment

Labour force estimates indicate that the largest proportion 61.6% of the employed population was in Abu Dhabi Region. The distribution by employment status revealed that the majority of employed persons in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi were paid employees 97.8%, while 1.4% were own-account workers.

A distribution by educational attainment, indicates that the largest proportion 21.6% of the employed population had Lower Secondary education, followed by Bachelor or equivalent education 21.3%. Among citizen's, a bachelor's degree was most common 33.8%.

A classification by main occupation indicates that Elementary occupations had the largest percentage of the employed population with 21.9% followed by Professionals with 16.0% Among employed citizens, Professionals accounted for the largest share, making up 31.8% of this segment, while the largest share 24.0% of employed non-citizens was in the Elementary occupations.

The largest proportion of the employed population was in the 'Activities of households as employers undifferentiated goods and services activity' with 15.7% followed by Construction activity with 15.1% 'Public administration and defense'; Compulsory Social security activities accounted for the largest proportion 58.1% of employed citizens, while 'Activities of households as employers undifferentiated goods and services' activity accounted for the largest proportion 17.2% of employed non-citizens.

As labour force data indicates, the private sector engaged the largest proportion (61.2%) of the employed population, while 13.7% worked for the government sector. As for employed citizen, 78.1% worked in the government sector and 5.3% in the private sector.

Labour Force Survey data also showed that the majority of the employed in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi are married (74.3%), while 24.1% of the employed never married. The survey data also showed that 44.5% of the total employed population in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi were working between 41-48 houre weekly.





### 5.3 Unemployment

The unemployment rate in 2018 was about 5.2% Increase from 5.0 according to 2017 estimates. The 20 to 24 years age group accounted for the largest proportion of the unemployed persons (25.9%). Data shows female unemployment rate in 2018 was higher than that of male, averaging 12.1% A distribution by educational attainment reveals that the majority of the unemployed (42.8%), hold an bachelor's degree, followed by upper secondary education 29.9%, while those with an educational attainment less than primary made up the lowest percentage (2.6%) of the unemployed. As the survey results indicate, 50.1% of the unemployed in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi are never married, while 47.3% of them married.




Figure 5.3.1 Unemployment Rate by Gender and Years

### 5.4 Outside Labour Force Population and Economic Dependency Ratio

As estimates indicate, the economic dependency ratio in Abu Dhabi Emirate was 53.4 dependents per 100 in the labour force for the total population, 29.1 for males and 123.8 for females. 21.0% of the total population aged 15 years and over were Outside Labour Force in year 2018, of which most were individuals engaged in household duties or students.
